n Barabara Brown Taylor's book, "An Altar in the World," she talks about Jesus' walking ministry. Jesus walked a lot, and he took his time. Jesus walked the countryside, villages, in the temple,

Jerusalem, and even on water. What if Jesus chose not to walk but instead had a "don't waste my time" type of ministry? Would he have spotted his future disciples fishing? Or stopped to identify a sick woman touching his cloak? Or pointed at a fig

tree as a teachable moment? The path Jesus took required slow steps, stops, and pauses along the way to offer good news, hope, healing and unity.

This year during Missions Month, we don't stop, but we do slow down. We slow down to walk with our partners and pause to

pay attention to the ways that God is working globally and locally. We acknowledge that as faithful disciples, we choose to walk in the same footsteps as Jesus and we do so in mercy, faith, unity. And because we are a missional people, we are committed to walking this earth, pausing and stopping along the way, bringing the very same good news that Jesus brought.
